Team Boreal Cranes at the Regatta Day

On July 29th was held the 44th Annual Regatta in Wabush. This major regional event concurs with a statutory holiday, Regatta Day, promoting the participation of Wabush, Labrador City, Fermont and the surroundings communities. Regatta Day is celebrated throughout the Labrador, but at different times from one region to another.

For its first year, Boreal Cranes sponsored a rowing team, in collaboration with Carol Auto Ford dealer.
