<u>Tessier, proud partner of Stornoway</u> Official Opening of the Renard Diamond Mine



On October 19, the official opening of the Renard diamond mine at Stornoway Diamond Corporation in Quebec took place.

Tessier is proud to have contributed to the success of this large-scale project from a vague exploration site to a new fully operational diamond mine. The first months of operation proved to be a success for commercial production.



construction began on July 10, 2014. The ore processing began on July 15, 2016. Stornoway is one of Canada's largest diamond exploration and development companies.

The Renard diamond mine is located approximately 250 km north of the Mistissini Cree community and 350 km north of Chibougamau in the James Bay region of north-central Quebec. On July 8, 2014, Stornoway announced the completion of the full financial package for the project in the amount of \$ 946 million;

<u>A success for Hydro-Québec Powerline Contracts</u> in Gaspésie and on the North Shore at the La Romaine Site

In Gaspésie, our 150-ton "picker" type crane was deployed outside the North Shore on behalf of our client Thirau, a company specializing in electrical work, to build a 230-kilovolt, a distance of approximately 25 kilometers, to link the Mi'kmaq communities wind farm to the Hydro-Québec network. The wind farm is a \$ 330 million project. This line required an amount of \$ 8.4 million.

The construction of the latter represented a major challenge for the company as it crossed three deep valleys, located in remote areas, isolated areas and rugged terrain.

The reliability of this crane contributed to the success of this project which lasted approximately 9 months. Our client was able to count on a team of experts whose know-how is known to be exceptional.

On the North Shore, this versatile and efficient crane also worked on the installation of towers for the power line at La Romaine 3 and 4, near Havre-St-Pierre and the Poste Montagnais near Sept-Iles.
