Construction of a renewable fuel plant in Port-Cartier

In Port-Cartier, on the St-Lawrence's North Shore, the Bioénergie AE Côte-Nord consortium, in partnership with AXOR Experts-Conseils are involved in the construction of a renwable fuel plant that will convert residual forest biomass into renewable fuel.

In order to shorten the construction schedule, it was decided to construct a part of the building's structure in prefabricated panels, while at the same time assembling components for the hot process in place on the floor of the future building.

In June, AXOR chose to work with Tessier Limitée as their lift engineering consultant to help them to find the best way to execute this project. Many scenarios and simulations were evaluated and rejected before establishing the definitive solution to assemble the

Tessier Limitée's 300 t crawler crane was required on site in the middle of November to perform the lifts. Many hours of labour and logistic planning were necessary to design, fabricate and test the lifting hardware specific to this project as well as to bring back the crane to Port-Cartier, by ship, which was on another jobsite, at the Meliadine mining operation, near Rankin Inlet, NU.

The crane arrived on November 1st, 2017 on the Claude A. Desgagnés, and was ready to lift the first panel (Panel "K") (25 m wide, 27.5 m high, 36 500 kg) on November 8th. Because of the wind considerations, the lift was done on November 9, starting at 04h30 and ending at 06h15. The panel was crawled with the crane on a distance of over a 100 m before being lowered on its anchoring points on the plant's floor.

The following week, the crane's boom was lengthen to 250 ft in order to be able to perform the lifts of the second panel (Panel "G2" $-25 \text{ m} \times 12 \text{m}$ high $\times 24 \ 000 \text{ kg}$) and the roof (25 m $\times 16 \text{ m}$ wide $\times 25 \ 000 \text{ kg}$). Being at the winds' mercy, we have to wait the late afternoon on November 14th to lift the second panel and the roof. At 21h45, both panels are in place and Tessier Limitée has fulfilled its commitment. The rest of the structure will be erected piece by piece.
